CAPTAIN NATHAN R. LAUSMANN

Capt Nathan Lausmann is a pilot and Executive Officer for the 14th Flying Training Wing, Columbus Air Force Base, Mississippi. He serves as key advisor to the commander of the Air Force's largest pilot training wing and supervises seven junior officers, managing official taskings, personnel actions, recognition programs, and senior leader engagements. He synchronizes efforts across three groups and 16 squadrons operating 212 aircraft and \$2.3B in assets, executing over 40,000 sorties and 56,000 flight hours annually to produce more than 400 pilots for the Air Force, Air National Guard, and allied partner nations. He coordinates the wing's role as the Air Force's dedicated proving ground for future pilot training programs and serves as the commander's liaison to Nineteenth Air Force, Air Education and Training Command, Headquarters Air Force, and congressional, state, and local leaders.

Captain Lausmann earned his commission through ROTC at Oregon State University in 2020 and completed Undergraduate Cyber Warfare Training as Distinguished Graduate in December 2021. His cyber experience spans in-garrison and deployed special operations missions, including key USSOCOM cyber roles overseeing a \$252M network of 15 classified enclaves, \$200M in active projects, and USSOCOM's primary datacenter, providing world-class communications and cyber capabilities for more than 53,000 special operations users globally. He led over 200 Airmen to deliver a diverse portfolio of terrestrial and airborne cyber capabilities that enabled specialized manned and unmanned ISR, mobility, and strike missions for AFSOC and USSOCOM operations worldwide. He also managed the base operational cybersecurity analysis team, protecting \$14.6B in assets and 60,000 annual flight hours. Prior to his current position, Captain Lausmann was Flight Commander, Special Missions, 27th Special Operations Communications Squadron, Cannon AFB, New Mexico, before completing Undergraduate Pilot Training at Columbus AFB, Miss., in November 2025.



Captain Lausmann has deployed as Director of J6 for a special operations group in support of Operations INHERENT RESOLVE, SPARTAN SHIELD, and YUKON JOURNEY. He has also led command and control response for multiple Presidentially directed global missions, including USSOCOM's largest ever emergency operation, amassing 4,500 personnel from five combatant commands.
